




Installing the Direct Connected Meter




The Acti 9 Isobar / Isobar P meter ready board is supplied with 125A 3P+N Switch Disconnector. The voltage protection fuses are installed but not required for direct connection.

Appropriate meter kit should be mounted on the din rail next to the incomer and the cables to be connected to the respective terminals as marked.

Installing the Indirect Connected Meter



The Acti 9 Isobar / Isobar P meter ready board is supplied with 125A 3P+N Switch Disconnector. The voltage protection fuses are installed but not connected.

Appropriate meter kit should be mounted on the din rail next to the incomer and the cables to be connected to the respective terminals as marked.

Current transformer version is pre cabled with only the voltage fuse protection cables left to terminate into the voltage protection fuses as shown.
