Product Description.

An Automatic 150N lifejacket that inflates on entering the water with a manual override toggle. Suitable for all weather conditions and will turn the wearer over into the safe back position. Suitable for swimmers.

Outer Cover.

Cover Closure.

Features.

The Winner is the perfect entry level lifejacket which is very comfortable due to the soft fleece collar and the inside cover.

Storage.

The lifejacket can withstand extremes in temperature of between - 30 and + 60°C, but should not be stored in direct sunlight.(please note that temperatures below 5°C can diminish the function of the lifejacket)

Service Inspection.

Lif jackets should have a daily inspection before wear with a full inspection at least annually as per the user's manual.

Service life expectation: Ten years.

Maintenance and Care.

Do not use as a cushion.

After use the life jacket should be rinsed in fresh water (**cartridge removed**) and dried and stored in a well-ventilated area away for naked flame or hot radiators etc. Hand washing can be performed using warm water and non- biological soap powder and dried afterward as above.

- The Cartridge has a time expiry date printed on it.
