#### **Important User Advice**

Always switch off mains supply before fitting or servicing.

This control is suitable for indoor use only.

Do not use Megger or similar high voltage instruments. Due to the fact this control contains electronic components that maybe damaged by high test voltages, they must be disconnected from the circuit before testing.

To prevent damage to the control, do not mix with conventional magnetic ballasts on the same electrical circuit.

At the end of life the luminaire is classed as WEEE under directive 2014/30/EU and should be disposed of in accordance with local legislation. Please note these luminaires are non-dimmable.

#### **Installation Procedure**

KSR recommends that you familiarise yourself with the installation. Once you are completely satisfied: Safely isolate the mains supply.

Locate the area's suitable to install this control on the luminaire.

#### As the detector responds to changes in temperature, avoid the following situations:

Avoid pointing the detector towards objects with highly reflective surfaces, such as mirrors etc.

Avoid mounting the detector near heat sources, such as heating vents, air conditioning units, lights etc.

Avoid pointing the detector towards objects that may move in the wind, such as curtains, tall plants etc

Ensure that no obstructions are in the line of sight.

Using a suitable hole install the sensor into the luminaire ensuring the seal is located to retain the correct IP rating.






Fig. 1 Brown - Live (In) Blue - Neutral (In) Yellow - Live (Out) Red - Positive (Out) Black - Negative (Out)

Connect the wiring as per Fig. 1. Please note: The Positive (Red) and Negative (Black) cables are to be connected to the positive and negative of a suitable dimmable driver using 1-10V input.

Switch on the power.



Important User Advice

The remote uses Infrared so needs to be in the line of sight to the sensor when programming.

- (After 8hours sensor will return to AUTO mode)
- Load switching OFF (After 8hours sensor will return to AUTO mode)
- Set sensor to work on detection of motion
- Sensor reset to default settings
- Automatically read-in the actual ambient light level and the sensor works according to this LUX value stored, range 0-2000LUX
- (B) Lock & Unlock remote controller buttons (Please note: The remote will automatically lock the remote buttons after approximately 10 minutes)
- Test mode
- Adjust LUX value from 10-2000LUX
- Set hold time
- Set dimming level hold time
  - Set dimming level or switch off load when there no motion detected
