USER INSTRUCTIONS

- Wear appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (P.P.E) when using holesaws.
- Ensure holesaw is correctly attached to the relevant adaptor for your machine.
- Use holesaw at the recommended speeds for the material being drilled as shown in the chart.
- Use as appropriate cutting lubricant when drilling in steel.
- After producing a hole, remove the “slug” of the material from the throat of the holesaw before commencing another hole.
- After pilot drill penetration be careful not to “bang” the holesaw onto the surface of the material to be drilled. This could damage or break the cutting teeth.

DID YOU KNOW?

M42 Steel (8% Cobalt) has excellent “hot hardness” properties. Therefore the cutting teeth don’t wear as quickly as other lower grades of HSS when working at higher temperatures

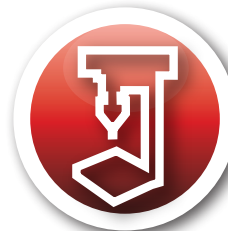
